SCENE 1

(WENDY'S ROOM)

The curtain opens to reveal a children's room with a window in the middle. On one bed, Wendy is reading a pirate story to her brother, John.

Wendy: Once upon a time there was a pirate called Hook, everybody called him Hook because he had a hook instead of one of his hands. Hook wanted to defeat Peter Pan because he was his enemy.

Wendy takes a coat hanger in one hand to act as a hook and a wooden sword in the other.

John: On Guard, Captain Hook!

John grabs another sword and stands up.

Wendy: I'm not afraid of you, Peter Pan.

John: Me neither.

Wendy: Take this, I'll teach you a lesson.

John: Ha, ha, ha. You will never catch me.

Wendy: Give me my treasure.

John: Never. The gold watch is mine.

Wendy: Take this!

John: Oh!

The father enters into the room looking for his gold watch.

Father: Kids! *The children are playing and the father continues looking for his watch.* Kids! (*They are not listening to him*) John! Wendy! Stop it.

Wendy and John: Hello Dad!

Father: Stop fighting! Okay guys, where is my gold watch?

Wendy and John: The treasure!

Father: Your treasure? Come on! Kids, where is my watch?

The children return the watch to their father.

Wendy: Sorry Dad, here it is.

Father: John!

John: We were playing at Pirates and the watch was our treasure.

Father: Playing Peter Hook and Captain Pan again?

John and Wendy start laughing.

Wendy: No, Dad. It's Captain Hook

John: And Peter Pan!

Father: Whatever! (*The father sees the book of short stories by Wendy, catch it and looking at Wendy*) Wendy, are you reading pirate tales again?

John continues playing pirates with his sword

Wendy: (*Lowering her head*) Yes...

John is stabbed with a sword and begins to cry.

The father puts the book in one bed and grabs John's arm.

Father: Don't you understand? Your brother is too small for a pirate tales.

Wendy: But Dad, it's not fair. I love to read stories! Please!

Father: Wendy, You are a grown up now. You are going to have to sleep in your own room. Good night.

John and Father leave the scene. Wendy takes the storybook lovingly and leaves it next to window. She goes to her bed and falls asleep. The light changes.

SCENE 2

(WENDY'S ROOM- NIGHT)

Peter Pan's shadow enters the room. Peter Pan comes on stage, looking for his shadow. Peter Pan enters with Tinkerbelle (a light that Peter carries Pan in his hand).

Peter Pan: *(Whispering)* Shadow! Shadow! Where are you? Tinkerbelle, help me! *Tinkerbelle says something into Peter Pan's ear.* By the bed? *Peter Pan over to the bed but cannot not find his shadow.* Tinkerbelle, the shadow is not here. Oh! You're making fun of me. Naughty! *(Peter Pan finds Wendy's book)* What do we have here? Oh! It is a pirate book! Captain Hook! *(Peter Pan drops the book on the floor and the noise wakes up Wendy)*

Wendy: *(Scared)* Who's there?

Peter Pan: Hello.

Wendy: Who are you? What are you doing here?

Peter Pan: I'm looking for my shadow. Is this your room?

Wendy: Yes.

Peter Pan: What's your name?

Wendy: My name is Wendy Moira Angela Darling. And you?

Peter Pan: Just Peter Pan!

Wendy takes her story book.

Wendy: *(To the audience)* Peter Pan! The hero from my pirate stories.

Peter Pan: And this is my friend, Tinkerbelle.

Wendy: Hi Tinkerbelle. Nice to meet you. You're so small!

Peter Pan: Sure, she's a fairy.

Wendy: A fairy?

Peter Pan: Yes, she is my fairy. She always comes with me. Wendy can you help me? I can't find my shadow. It's hidden somewhere in this room.

Wendy: Okay!

Peter Pan and Wendy seek the shadow but they can not find it. Peter Pan asks the audience and with their help to find his shadow.

When the song ends the shadow leaves the stage.

Peter Pan: Thanks Wendy, now I must go.

Wendy: Wait! Where are you going?

Peter Pan: Home!

Wendy: Do you live here in London?

Peter Pan: No, I live on the island of Neverland with the Lost Boys.

Wendy: And is this island a nice place to live?

Peter Pan: Yeah, It's great! Would you like to come with me? (*Taking the story book and giving it to Wendy*) You can tell stories to The Lost Boys. The boys love stories.

Wendy: Okay, let's go.

Peter Pan: We have to fly to get to Neverland.

Wendy: Fly? Of course not ... I can't fly.

Peter Pan: I'll teach you. First we need some fairy dust. Tinkerbelle! Come here. Can you give us some fairy dust? (*Peter Pan takes the magic dust from Tinkerbelle and takes Wendy's hand*) Now you are ready! Follow me.

Peter Pan and Wendy leave the scene. The set becomes a puppet theatre. Wendy and Peter Pan fly to the island. The scenery changes to an island.

SCENE 3

THE ISLAND OF NEVERLAND

Captain Hook and his assistant Smith enter.

Hook: It's very hot ... my God ... this tropical heat is exhausting!

Smith: Why don't we have a swim in the sea?

Hook: Don't be silly I can't swim with... with ... **(Looking at his hook)** No.... We have a mission. To catch Peter Pan! Telescope!

Smith: Here it is, My Captain.

Smith gives the telescope to Hook.

Hook: Wow! This is the perfect place to wait for Peter Pan. He will come sooner or later and we will be ready to catch him. Smith, I need two trees here to hide ourselves. Come on! You lazy man! I have seen Peter Pan flying. **(He gives the telescope to Smith and approaches the audience)** Have you seen Peter Pan? Where? Peter Pan! Peter Pan! The cause of all my misery.... I'll find you and I'll catch you. **(Hook looks at his hand)**...

Hook approaches Smith who is looking the wrong way through the telescope.

Smith: I can't see anything, Captain.

Hook: Of course, you can't. You are holding it the wrong way around. **(Smith turns the telescope and looks through it. He sees Hook's face very close and gets a fright, and jumping backward)** And that eye patch? You always have to wear your eye patch over your right eye.

Smith: Yes, Captain. **(Smith changes his patch to the other eye)**

Hook: A good pirate draws his sword fast.

Hook quickly pulls his sword. Smith tries to draw his sword but he can't.

Hook: A good pirate knows how to count the steps to the treasure.

Smith: I can count very well, Captain. **(Smith follows the steps, bumps into Hook and falls over, clashing with Hook's sword., Hook leaps forward)**

Hook: Oh! Smith! You'll never be a good pirate.

Hook: And now let's go to find Peter Pan. *(To audience)* If you see Peter Pan, call me, ok? I will be watching you. So, be good boys and girls.

Exit Hook and Smith.

Enter Peter Pan and Wendy.

Peter Pan: Wendy, here we are. This is the Neverland.

Wendy: Wow, it's really beautiful!

Peter Pan: Are you hungry?

Wendy: Yes, I am very hungry....

Peter Pan: *(Takes a bowl filled with fruit)* We have bananas, coconuts, pineapples....

Wendy: An orange ... *(Wendy takes an orange)* Mmm.... delicious...

Peter Pan: *Pointing to the audience.* And these are The Lost Children.

Wendy: Hi guys.

Peter Pan: Wait, I'll introduce you. *(Peter Pan drops down into the audience and gets a few children who come up on stage, they are introduced to Wendy. They dance and sing a song together)*

Wendy: Nice to meet you! It was great. Neverland... . I love it! And now can we play pirates?

Peter Pan: Pirates? ... No

Wendy: Why not?

Peter Pan: We do not play pirates!

Wendy: Why not?

Peter Pan: Because we fight against Hook and his pirates. We don't play, it's real.

Wendy: Hook?

Peter Pan: Yes, Captain Hook is an evil pirate who hates me.

Wendy: Why?

Peter Pan: He lost his hand fighting with me, and now he wears a hook.

Wendy: We have to look after children.

Peter Pan: Wendy, you stay here, I will take the children to safety. Stay here and do not move.

Wendy: Yes my Captain!

Peter Pan: I'll be back in a minute.

Peter Pan accompanies children to their seats. Wendy is alone on stage. Captain Hook enters and kidnaps Wendy.

Peter Pan: Wendy! Wendy! Where's Wendy? (*To the audience*). Have you seen Wendy? ***Peter Pan leaves the stage, looking for Wendy.***

SCENE 4

THE PIRATE'S SHIP

Captain Hook and Smith enter.

Hook: Oh! I hate this jungle, and these mosquitoes. Smith! Where is our ship?

Smith: I don't know sir.

Hook: Smith, take this tree away!

Smith: Yes, sir!

Hook: Tree!!!!

Hook: Smith, where is our boat?

Smith: Sir, I know where the boat is!

Hook: Do you know?

Smith: Yes, sir, it is behind those trees.

Hook: Oh, yes! Thank you very much my little, little monkey. The boat is very important for a pirate. I will teach you how to be a good pirate.

Hook: Okay, Smith, now clean the deck.

While Smith cleans, Captain Hook covers fire for his telescope.

Hook: Oh, my treasure!!! One, two, three....Smith!!!! I had twelve coins and now there are only eleven, where is that missing coin? Oh, Smith, go and clean the toilets.

Smith: Ok, sir. *Smith leaves the stage.*

Hook: Um! Let's see. Smith, go and fetch the girl.

Smith: Yes, sir.

Smith leaves the stage.

Hook: We are here. *He opens a map and looks at it to work out where he is. (To the audience)* Sailors, turn to port! *Hook goes to the wheel and starts turning it.* Port side, Starboard..... *(Taking the spyglass)* Where are you, Peter Pan?

Smith (Off): Here is the girl, sir.

Wendy has her feet and hands tied, and a handkerchief in her mouth. Hook goes over to her.

Hook: When Peter Pan comes to rescue you, I will catch him. What is your name?

Wendy tries to speak but she can't because she has a handkerchief in the mouth.

Hook: Didn't you hear me, girl? I said, what's your name?!

Wendy tries to speak but she cannot.

Hook: It's rude not to answer. It's not polite. *(Hook realizes that Wendy can not speak because of the handkerchief and takes it out)* OK ... OK....

Wendy: My name is Wendy, Hook.

Hook: Captain Hook!

Wendy: Sorry.... Captain Hook.

Wendy goes to the mast of the boat to look for Peter Pan, Hook looks through his telescope at the sky.

Hook: Look, Peter Pan, here is Wendy, come and save her! Ha, ha, ha.... You see, Wendy, Peter Pan isn't coming to rescue you. Okay, jump to the sea!

Wendy: No, please! *(To the audience)* Guys, help me to call Peter. Peter! Peter!....

Hook: No! Silence, silence.... Peter Pan will never come....

Peter Pan enters.

Peter Pan: On guard, Hook!

Wendy: Peter!

Hook: Peter Pan!

Peter Pan: Wendy!

Hook: What do we have here; our friend is in love with Wendy!

Peter Pan: Let Wendy go, now!

Hook: Or what? Ha ha ha

Peter Pan: You will lose your other hand.

Hook: Captain Hook!

Peter Pan: It's time to prove yourself.

Hook: It will be my pleasure, young man.

Peter Pan: No, Hook, the pleasure is all mine.

Peter Pan and Hook fight with their swords.

Hook: Finally! Peter Pan! I've catch you.

Hook: You're finished Peter Pan.

Wendy takes Peter Pan sword.

Wendy: Hook! This is not over yet...En garde!

Peter Pan: Wendy ... Be careful with that sword!

Hook: Ha ha ha ... Listen to Peter Pan, don't hurt yourself.

Wendy throws Hook's hat to the ground with the sword. Hook gets angry. He picks up his hat.

Peter Pan: No, please.....

Hook: It's too late for begging.

Wendy and Hook start fighting with their swords.

Wendy: Are you really sorry? Ok, I forgive you.

Hook tries to hurt Wendy but Tinkerbell starts to bother him and finally Wendy wins.

Wendy: Jump into the water!

Hook: Smith.... the ship!

Peter Pan: No, jJump into the water!

Hook: What?

Peter Pan and Wendy: Jump into the water!

Hook: I can't swim with my hook.

Peter Pan: Good bye Hook!

Hook: Captain Hook! I'll be back! Ooooooooooh...

Hook falls overboard. Peter Pan and Wendy embrace.

Peter Pan: Wendy thank you for saving me.

Wendy: You're welcome.

Peter Pan: We must go back to Neverland, the lost boys are waiting.

Wendy: Peter wait I have to go home, to my family.

Peter Pan: Please, stay longer.

Wendy: I can't.... Why don't you come with me?

Peter Pan: Yes..... And you, will you read me stories?

Wendy: Of course I will, Peter Pan....
